Abstract submission guidelines 2026

The CoSRH Conference 2026 is an excellent opportunity for clinicians and scientists to present their research finding to their national and international peers from the sexual and reproductive healthcare community.

Submitted abstracts should present **research** or evidence-based **quality improvement** actions in the field of sexual and reproductive healthcare. We particularly welcome abstracts around the theme of environmental sustainability.

Eligibility

All healthcare professionals and researchers working in or with an interest in SRH. We welcome abstracts from those based in the UK and internationally. Make sure to complete your submission by **23:59 BST on Monday 1 June 2026** [here](#).

Preparing your abstract

- You must be presenting your own research and must ensure you have permission from others involved to present your findings.
- The maximum number of words per abstract is **300** – abstracts will be rejected if they exceed this.
- An anonymised selection process will be used, so please **do not include any identifying features such as names of hospitals, medical schools, clinics or cities** in the title or text of the abstract
- Do not include the name of authors. The names of the authors and their affiliations (institutions) will be requested separately when you submit the abstract on Oxford Abstracts
- For the abstract title:
 - Do not use abbreviations
 - Capitalise only the first word, not every word
 - There should be no full stop at the end
- Please use the following format:
 - Introduction - including aims of the study
 - Methodology
 - Results
 - Conclusions

- Abstracts should refer to completed work and not work in progress – please ensure that results are given in the abstract (do not state: ‘results will be presented at the meeting’)
- Please note that case studies will not be accepted
- Abstracts submitted with no results presented will be rejected
- Any abbreviations should be in parenthesis after the full word the first time it appears
- References should be kept to a minimum and should be consistently presented in Vancouver (numbered) style
- Sources of funding should be indicated at the bottom of the abstract.

If successful

All correspondence will be sent to the registered submitter on Oxford Abstracts. It is the responsibility of this person to pass on any relevant information regarding the submitted abstract and the conference to any other authors.

Up to eight of the highest scoring abstracts will be invited to deliver an oral presentation in person at the conference in Manchester on Tuesday 29 September 2026. A number of other successful applicants will be invited to submit a poster also to appear in-person in Manchester. You must be available to attend the conference in-person if your abstract is successful. Please plan accordingly.

Oral presenters

- If your abstract is accepted as an oral presentation, you will receive guidelines on how to prepare your presentation including timings and when you need to submit slides.
- Each successful submission will receive a slot to present their research and answer questions on the main stage. The main stage will be live streamed to virtual delegates and made available online to all delegates for a limited time after the live conference.
- Presentations will be marked on presentation content (quality of methods, results, conclusion, originality) and presentation delivery (presentation style, time keeping, eye contact) during the live event.

Poster presenters

- If your abstract is selected as a poster, you will be informed and instructions on when and how to submit your final poster will be emailed directly to you.

Terms and conditions

- If you are invited to deliver an oral presentation or a physical poster, at least one presenting author must register and pay in full to attend the conference in Manchester by **Monday 13 July 2026 at 23:59 BST**. However, we recommend booking earlier than this date to avail of an early bird discounted ticket.
- Please note that failure to book a place may result in your abstract and presentation being withdrawn from the conference.
